

Mrs. Brockman: English 1 and English 3

- Binder or folder for your own personal organization of assignments & handouts
- Loose-leaf binder paper or a notebook for personal notes/assignments
- Pencils and pens—blue or black only
- Highlighter set: Green, yellow, pink, blue

Mr. Iske: Loose leaf paper or notebook, folder, pen, pencil, good attitude

Mr. Krecklow: Two spiral notebooks, folder and pencils

Mrs. Mohr: Spanish 1 & 2: 1" or 1 ½" 3 ring binder, 1 package of 7 or more dividers, 1 folder with fasteners, paper

Spanish 3 & 4: Two 1" 3 ring binders, 1 package of dividers, paper

Mrs. Simon: English 2: one 1 1/2" binder, folder with pockets, 1 subject notebook, blue or black ink pens or pencils, highlighter set (yellow, green, pink, orange). Optional: dry erase marker

English 4 Composition:-two 1" binders, 1 subject notebook, blue or black ink pens or pencils, highlighter set (yellow, green, pink, orange)

English 4 Literature: 1" binder, 1 subject notebook, blue or black ink pens or pencils

Applied Composition: 1" binder, 1 subject notebook, folder with pockets, blue or black ink pens or pencils

American Literature: 1" binder, 1 subject notebook, blue or black ink pens or pencils

Mr. Stanley: Paper to take notes on (spiral bound or loose in a 3 ring binder), a folder to put papers/resources in and a one subject spiral notebook. For Physical Science students, a calculator that does squares and square roots is needed. For Physics/Chemistry students a scientific calculator is needed.
