TELL AN ADULT ABOUT SAFETY CONCERNS

We all want school to be a safe place. Your report is important.

You can make a positive difference by telling an adult your concerns about dangerous or troubling behavior. Safe2Help is there when you need to tell someone, and a trusted adult is not available.



WHAT TO REPORT

- Bullying or online bullying.
- People talking about hurting themselves, other people, or animals.
- Concerns about someone's anger problems or fighting.
- Worries about someone who is extremely sad or troubled.
- Dangerous online or social media activity.
- Someone talking about or showing you weapons like guns or knives.



TELL AN ADULT...IT IS SAFE TO HELP

HOW TO HELP

- **TELL A TRUSTED ADULT**

Tell a parent, teacher, or school counselor about your concerns.

- **CALL THE SAFE2HELP NUMBER OR GET THE APP**

Talk to a counselor anytime about your concerns. They will pass them onto your school or other adults who need to know.

- **NO NAMES NEEDED**

You do not need to give your name.

- **ADULTS AT YOUR SCHOOL WILL HELP**

A team in your school will work together to make the situation better.
